- On Friday, October 7th, Riverhead High School Cosmetology student, Kamila Krupa, was featured on TV55 News attaching a pink hair extension in reporter Jodi Goldberg's hair as part of the "Pink Hair for Hope" fundraiser at the Harry B. Ward Technical and Academic Center.
- More than 150 students and their parents attended the Riverhead High School Guidance Department's "College Night" on October 6 in the High School Cafeteria that explored college options and helped provide an understanding of the admission process.
- On October 4, 1,000 schools were selected by their principals to be recognized as part of "A Day Made Better"... a national cause campaign by Office Max facilitated in partnership with non-profit Adopt-A-Classroom to end teacher-funded classrooms. This year's recipient was Kindergarten teacher, Kim Benkert, at the Phillips Avenue Elementary School. In addition to supplies given to Kim, the school received \$3,000 worth of much-needed school supplies. The district extends much appreciation to Office Max to provide economic relief for teachers.

The District has authorized Ms. Sanders to file the independent audits with the State as required by law, and have also asked her to attend an upcoming meeting of the Board of Education to issue a report to the full Board of Education.
