Opportunity for Superintendent

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- -The 4th Annual Columbia Teachers College Institute was held. It is a week-long series of workshops that focuses on literacy and promoted love for reading and writing.
- -The two-day Administrators Workshop (August 24-25) at the Riverhead Firehouse on Roanoke Avenue is being conducted. The workshop will focus on instruction, lessons and curriculum maps, the promotion of a higher order of thinking skills and concepts, review and use of data, and development of an action plan to move the district forward.
- -Smartboards have been installed in all K-6 classrooms districtwide. Buildings and Grounds and Technology departments have been working around the clock to accomplish the installation of interactive, multi-media for our students.
- -Our Buildings and Grounds crew have been working hard to make our buildings ready for opening of school. A number of bathrooms are being made compliant, fences have been repaired between Pulaski Street School and the District Office, and our buildings are getting into shape for September 7, the first day of school for students.

Mrs. Berezny gave a report on the recent meeting of the Audit Committee which reviewed risk assessment scope areas for consideration for the fiscal year 2010-2011. They include:

- Student attendance (E-School)

The closing of the district's books for the fiscal year 20009-2010 must be completed by September 20. On October 12, there will be an Audit Committee Meeting open to the public at 5:00 p.m. In November, a presentation will be made to the public by the district auditors.

Based on recommendations made by the state auditors, Mr. Meyer stated that a number of Board policies need to be revisited while others are new. It is the Board's intent to be compliant and revamp what is necessary within the next month or two.

Mrs. Cotten-DeGrasse announced that two other committees will be up and running in September. They are:

She invited the community to share in reassessing a bond proposal to address overcrowding and infrastructure issues. As part of the Community Advisory Council, as many segments of the community as possible are encouraged to participate in this endeavor.

Mrs. Berezny commented on her pleasure to attend breakfast for the Administrators Workshop being held today and tomorrow at the new Riverhead firehouse, and of how pleased she is to see that the twin towers at Pulaski are being taken care of.

Ms. DeVito commented on the World War II Memorial Monument and that a solution to provide the lighting could be explored by the new Director of Science whereby students would design a solar project using some of the same concepts that were used for the solar powered boat in Greenport, *Glory*.

Mrs. Cotten-DeGrasse announced that the presentation of the Honorary Development Achievement Citation to Mr. Griffing will be postponed until the next Board meeting.

Ms. Barbara Barosa, President of the R.C.F.A., expressed appreciation for the invitation to participate in the New Teacher Institute on August 18-19 at Aquebogue School where fifteen new teachers were welcomed into the district. She thanked the Board of Education and central administration for their support and collaboration as we look forward to a good school year.

-A parent of a special needs child expressed concern on the self-contained classrooms now at Aquebogue (formerly at Riley). She stated that the program took twelve years to develop and requested that the Board consider returning the classrooms to Riley. (Ms. Carney explained that the decision was not an easy one and was based on keeping the program intact as it was by also addressing the extreme overcrowding at Riley and concern to limit the movement of the children.)
