On behalf of the Board of Education, Dr. Scricca extended a big *Thank You* to the community for their support in passing both the 2010-2011 budget and the proposition to utilize the Capital Reserve Fund hat will enable us to put a new roof and install an elevator at the Roanoke Avenue Elementary School without any cost to the district. She also stated that the state budget remains un-adopted more than a month past the statutory deadline, and that the Race to the Top (RTTT) grant is being reapplied for by New York State...some concessions from the teacher unions might enable us to be more competitive at a national level.

Opportunity for Superintendent

Mrs. Cotten-DeGrasse commented on a New York State School Boards Advocacy Alert that asks people to support the concessions made by the teacher unions and that she could not support the RTTT Plan in its entirety because of its possible impact on and funding of charter schools. (Dr. Scricca stated that another alert talked about the legislature funding charter schools differently. Our issue is that charter schools should be fully funded directly by the state. The aspect of funding is on the table and we are trying to get our legislators to reexamine this issue.)

Opportunity for Board Members

Mrs. Berezny commented on the following:

- encouraged the community to visit the Riverhead Fire House to see the mural done by High School students
- her attendance to the Blue Masques production of FAME, the NJROTC Spaghetti Dinner on May 6th, Council for Unity Induction Ceremony at Giorgio's on May 6th, Art in Action at the High School, the Riverhead High School concert, the National Honor Society induction of 2010-2011 candidates to membership at the

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Riverhead Middle School, the Riverhead High School National Honor Society Induction Dinner, and a dedication ceremony for a new garden planted at the Aquebogue Elementary School courtyard in memory of Allen Goleski, former head custodian. .

Mr. Meyer commended the Girls Varsity Team and coaches for a job well done in recent competition, and expressed his pleasure to attend the Riverhead High School Foreign Language Honor Society Induction Ceremony on May 20th.
