On Tuesday, Jan. 7, the Board of Education unanimously adopted a bond resolution to fund major repairs and renovations to all schools in the district. Residents will have an opportunity to vote on the bond on Tuesday, Feb. 25. There are two separate propositions totaling \$97,049,340, of which \$500,000 will be funded through the district's voter-approved capital reserve fund.
