		Shall the Board of Education of the Riverhead Central School District be authorized to expend a sum not to exceed \$469,470.00 from the "Cafeteria Capital Reserve Fund" established on May 15, 2018 for the following purpose(s): replacement of the serving lines at the Riverhead High School cafeteria, the Riverhead Middle School cafeteria, and the Pulaski Street Elementary School; installation of a walk-in freezer at the Pulaski Street Elementary School; improvements to the serving area entrances at the Pulaski Street Elementary School; and incidental work required to be performed? The Cafeteria Capital Reserve is funded from surplus money generated by the Cafeteria program and not taxpayer dollars. Since the funds to be expended hereunder are from the Cafeteria Capital Reserve Funds, approval of this proposition will not require a tax levy upon the real property of the district.
