Sex Offender E-mail Alert Program

Dear Families,

Funded by the county, state and federal governments, *Parents for Megan's Law* (PFML) is an organization dedicated to the prevention of childhood sexual abuse through the provision of education, advocacy, counseling, policy and legislative support services. Subscribers to the e-mail alert system will be notified when low, moderate or high-risk sex offenders move into the Suffolk County Police Department's jurisdiction, and will be directed to the *Parents for Megan's Law* website to access a full copy of the notification provided by county law enforcement agencies.

Attached is a registration form from *Parents for Megan's Law* for those who wish to enroll in the e-mail alert system. Once you have registered, you will be notified via e-mail each time the Suffolk or Nassau County Police Departments distribute a sex offender notice. If you choose not to register for the e-mail alert, you may still access the information by logging onto the PFML website at www.parentsformeganslaw.org. You may also register for alerts on-line by following the links from our district website at www.riverhead.net. Residents without Internet access may utilize computer facilities at your local library to check for updates. In addition, notices will continue to be available to be picked up in person at the District Office.

It is unfortunate, but necessary, that we all take this opportunity to review safety rules with our children and remind them to avoid circumstances that increase their vulnerability. Please keep this in the proper perspective and reassure your children that we do have a safe community, but that they need to be alert and careful.

Please be aware that according to New York State Law, "It is illegal to use this information to commit a crime against any of these individuals or to engage in illegal discrimination or harassment against these people."

We will continue to update our staff in each of our schools. I assure you that we will remain vigilant in order to assure the safety of your children. Should you have any further questions, please contact the Parents for Megan's Law Resource and Support Center Helpline at 631-689-2672.
